Proverbs = Author- Mostly Solomon , Purpose-To show us how God's truth applies to every day life, Written- Around 1014 B.C., Key People- Solomon, Key Places-

Ecclesiastes= Author- Solomon, Purpose- To show the emptiness of life without God, Written- Around 935 B.C, Key People- Solomon, Key Places-

Song of Solomon = Author- Solomon, Purpose- To tell about the love between a bride and groom, Written- Around 971 B.C. to 931 B.C., Key People- Solomon, the Shulamite woman and her brothers, and the young Jerusalem woman, Key Places- Israel
