SMS Privacy Policy

Purpose

Ministry of Reconciliation Church (MRC) respects the privacy of individuals who communicate with the church through SMS text messaging. This SMS Privacy Policy explains how information associated with MRC's SMS messaging service is collected, used, protected, and shared.

Information We Collect and Use

MRC may receive mobile telephone numbers, SMS opt-in and consent information, message content, and related information voluntarily provided by individuals who communicate with the church. This information is used to transmit, receive, facilitate, document, and respond to conversational church and ministry communications. Messages may include pastoral or ministry support, prayer-related communication, visitor follow-up, responses to ministry needs, meeting or appointment coordination, requested church information, and other related one-to-one church communications.

Mobile Opt-In Information and Data Sharing

MRC does not sell, rent, or share mobile telephone numbers, SMS opt-in information, or SMS consent information with third parties or affiliates for marketing or promotional purposes.

Mobile opt-in information will not be shared with third parties for marketing purposes.

Text messaging originator opt-in data and consent will not be shared with third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

Limited Service Provider and Legal Disclosures

Information may be disclosed to telecommunications carriers, messaging platform providers, and other service providers only as reasonably necessary to transmit and deliver SMS messages, operate or support the messaging service, protect the security of the service, or provide services requested by the individual. Such disclosures are not for third-party marketing or promotional purposes. Information may also be disclosed when reasonably necessary to comply with applicable law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request, or to protect the rights, safety, or property of MRC or others.

SMS Consent

Consent to receive SMS messages from MRC is voluntary and is not a condition of receiving ministry services, attending worship services, participating in church activities, or receiving

assistance. Individuals may withdraw consent at any time by replying STOP to an SMS message from MRC. Reply HELP for assistance.

Data Protection

MRC takes reasonable administrative and organizational measures to protect information associated with its SMS messaging service from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. No method of electronic transmission or storage can be guaranteed to be completely secure.
